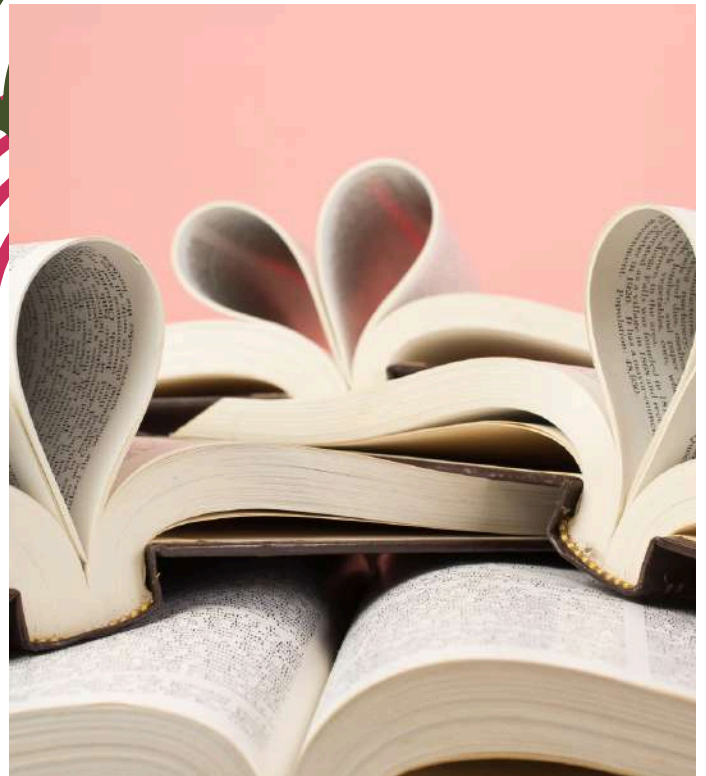

Twin Isles Country Club has a ladies golf association (TILGA) which is open to all TICC women golf members. Golfers of all levels are welcome and encouraged to join this fun group of ladies. There are both 18-hole and 9-hole groups and play is on Wednesday mornings throughout the year. Valentine's Day Champagne

INGREDIENTS:

- Raspberry Sorbet
- Pink Champagne

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Scoop Raspberry Sorbet into glass
2. Add Pink Champagne
3. Garnish with Fresh Raspberries



Strawberry Vanilla Valentines Margarita

INGREDIENTS

- 3 ½ oz strawberry vanilla simple syrup
- 2 oz [tequila](#)
- 1 oz Cointreau
- Ice
- Sprite amount is up to you.
- Splash of lime
- Salt or sugar for rim optional

INSTRUCTIONS

1. In a beverage shaker, add ice. I used regular ice for this, and placed the cute heart ice into the serving glass.
2. Add your strawberry vanilla simple syrup, tequila, Cointreau, and splash of lime.
3. Shake well.
4. Pour mixture into glass.
5. Top with sprite and additional sliced strawberries.
6. Makes 1 large cocktail or 2 small cocktails.



Red Velvet Pancakes with Cream Cheese Glaze

INGREDIENTS:

- 2 1/3 cups all-purpose flour (scoop and level to measure)
- 3 Tbsp cocoa powder
- 2 tsp baking powder
- 1/2 tsp baking soda
- 1/2 tsp salt
- 2 cups milk
- 2 Tbsp white vinegar
- 1/2 cup granulated sugar
- 2 large eggs
- 1 1/2 Tbsp red food coloring
- 2 tsp vanilla extract
- 1/3 cup salted butter, melted
- 1 recipe Cream Cheese Glaze, recipe follows
- fresh raspberries and mint leaves, for garnish (optional)

Cream Cheese Glaze:

- 6 oz cream cheese, softened
- 6 Tbsp butter, softened
- 2 cups powdered sugar
- 1/3 cup milk, plus more if desired
- 1/2 tsp vanilla extract

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Preheat an electric non-stick griddle to 350 degrees. In a mixing bowl, whisk together flour, cocoa powder, baking powder, baking soda and salt, set aside. Measure out milk into a liquid measuring cup and whisk in vinegar, allow mixture to rest for 2 minutes.
2. Pour milk mixture into a separate large mixing bowl and add in sugar, eggs, red food coloring, vanilla and melted butter. Whisk mixture until well combined. While whisking, slowly add in dry ingredients and mix just until combine.
3. Butter griddle if necessary and pour about a 1/4 - 1/3 cup batter (depending on how large you want your pancakes) at a time onto hot griddle (you can also use the back of measuring cup or spoon to lightly spread batter from center out to the edge a bit, so they aren't thicker in the center than they are on the edges).
4. Cook until bubbles begin to appear on the top surface of the pancakes then flip and cook opposite side until pancake is cooked through (I didn't want the tops of the pancakes to be brownish red so I flipped them a little earlier than I normally do with pancakes, I didn't wait for many bubbles).
5. Serve warm with cream cheese glaze and garnish with fresh raspberries and mint leaves if desired.
6. For the cream cheese glaze: in a mixing bowl, using an electric hand mixer set on medium speed, blend together cream cheese and butter until well combine and fluffy, about 2 minutes.
7. Add in remaining ingredients and mix about 1 minute until well combine, adding additional milk to thin if desired. Store in an airtight container in refrigerator.



Honey Garlic Pork Chops

INGREDIENTS:

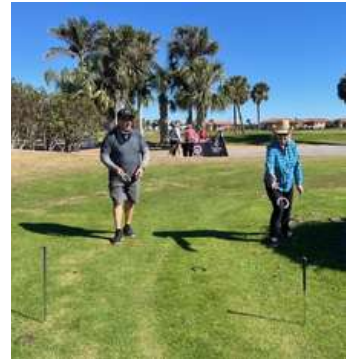
- 4 pork chops bone-in or boneless
- 1 pinch salt to season
- 1 pinch pepper to season
- 1 teaspoon garlic powder
- 2 tablespoons olive oil
- 1 tablespoon unsalted butter
- 6 cloves garlic minced
- 1/4 cup honey
- 1/4 cup chicken broth
- 2 tablespoons rice wine vinegar or apple cider vinegar, or any white vinegar
- 1-2 tablespoons water (optional)

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Preheat the oven broiler (or grill) to medium-high heat. Season the chops with salt, pepper, and garlic powder before cooking.
2. Heat oil in a pan or skillet over medium-high heat until hot. Sear chops until golden on each side and cooked through (about 4-5 minutes on each side). Transfer to a plate; set aside.
3. Reduce heat to medium. Melt butter in the same pan, scraping up any browned bits from the bottom of the pan. Sauté garlic until fragrant (about 30 seconds). Add the honey, broth, and vinegar. Increase heat to medium-high and continue to cook until the sauce reduces and thickens slightly (about 3-4 minutes) while stirring occasionally. Add 1-2 tablespoons of water if the sauce thickens too much.
4. Add pork back to the pan, baste generously with the sauce, and broil/grill for 1-2 minutes or until edges are slightly charred.
5. Garnish with parsley and serve over vegetables, rice, pasta, or salad.
