Any member wishing to develop an interest group or club should contact Peggy Miller, Office Manager, to receive information and an application.











TWIN ISLES LADIES GOLF ASSOCIATION (TILGA)

Twin Isles Country Club has a ladies golf association (TILGA) which is open to all TICC women golf members. Golfers of all levels are welcome and encouraged to join this fun group of ladies. There are both 18-hole and 9-hole groups and play is on Wednesday mornings throughout the year. The 18 "holers" typically tee off around 9am and the 9 "holers" tee off immediately following the last 18-hole group. The Golf Pro pairs golfers and assigns tee times based on who has signed up to play each week. Weekly signup sheets are posted on the pro-shop bulletin board.

The TILGA year runs from May to April and includes both a summer season (May to Mid-October) and a regular season (Mid-October – April). The cost to participate in TILGA for the 2024-2025 year is \$45 and includes both the summer and regular seasons. You can join any time during the year.

Our Member/Guest event is coming up in early March. There will be practice rounds and a taco bar/cocktail party on Tuesday, March 4 with the golf event, prizes and lunch happening on Wednesday, March 5. The 4-person team requires just 1 TILGA member. The signup sheet is posted in the pro-shop. Also in March is the "Gals and Pals" - 9-hole event followed by dinner on March 26.

Watch for the signup sheet in the Pro shop.

If you are interested in learning more about TILGA, talk to any of the members, or contact one of the officers listed below. Being a part of TILGA is a great way to meet many of the TICC women golfers, to play golf each week, to improve your game, to see new and old friends, to have fun and maybe win some prizes!








Drunken Leprechaun

INGREDIENTS

- 4 ounces orange juice
- 2 ounces Jameson Irish Whiskey
- 1 ounce blue curacao
- Ice
- · orange slice for garnish
- · maraschino cherry for garnish

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Add orange juice, whiskey, and blue curacao to a highball glass with ice.
- 2. Stir and garnish with an orange slice & maraschino cherry



Orish Mudslide

INGREDIENTS

- 1 oz Irish cream liqueur
- 1 oz coffee-flavored liqueur
- 1 oz vodka
- 2 scoops vanilla ice cream
- A splash of milk
- Green food coloring just a drop or two to get that perfect green color

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Add the Irish cream, coffee-flavored liqueur, vodka, vanilla ice cream, and milk into the blender.
- 2.Put a drop or two of green food coloring. Start with a little; you can always add more to get the color you want.
- 3. Blend until smooth.
- 4. Pour it into your glass and enjoy.

Easy St. Patrick's Day Dessert Parfait

INGREDIENTS:

- 1 (3.9oz.) box instant chocolate pudding
- 2 cups whole milk
- 1 (3.9oz.) box instant vanilla pudding
- 2 cups heavy cream
- ½ teaspoon vanilla extract or mint, depending on your tastes
- Green food coloring
- 8 Oreo cookies feel free to pick your favorite flavor
- 8 ounces whipped topping thawed

Decorations/Toppings:

- Airheads Xtremes Rainbow Candy
- · chocolate gold coins
- sprinkles
- Oreo crumbs

- 1.Add the chocolate pudding mix and milk to a medium mixing bowl and use a hand mixer or whisk to beat for 2 minutes. Place in the refrigerator for 5 minutes to set up. 1 (3.9oz.) box instant chocolate pudding,2 cups whole milk
- 2.In a separate bowl, add the vanilla pudding mix and heavy cream and beat together at low speed. Then gradually increase speed and mix until the mixture is light and fluffy. Beat in the vanilla extract and green food coloring (to your desired color).1 (3.9oz.) box instant vanilla pudding,2 cups heavy cream, Green food coloring, ½ teaspoon vanilla extract
- 3.Place a thin layer of the chocolate pudding into each of your 4 cups. Then layer on some of the green whipped pudding. Next, add a layer of crumbled Oreo cookies. Then a layer of whipped topping. Repeat these layers once more, ending with the whipped topping. 8 Oreo cookies,8 ounces whipped topping
- 4.Decorate with a rainbow airhead cut in half and arched like a rainbow, a chocolate gold coin, sprinkles and Oreo crumbs. Airheads Xtremes Rainbow Candy, chocolate gold coins, sprinkles, Oreo crumbs
- 5. Place them in the fridge until ready to serve.



Reuben Dip

INGREDIENTS:

- 4 packages (2 ounces each) thinly sliced deli corned beef, finely chopped 1 package (8 ounces) cream cheese, cubed
- 1 can (8 ounces) sauerkraut, rinsed and drained
- 1 cup sour cream
- 1 cup shredded Swiss cheese
- 1/4 cup Thousand Island salad dressing, optional
- Rye bread or crackers

INSTRUCTIONS:

1.In a 1-1/2-qt. slow cooker, combine the first 5 ingredients. If desired, stir in Thousand Island dressing. Cover and cook on low for 2 hours or until cheese is melted; stir until blended. Serve warm with bread or crackers.
